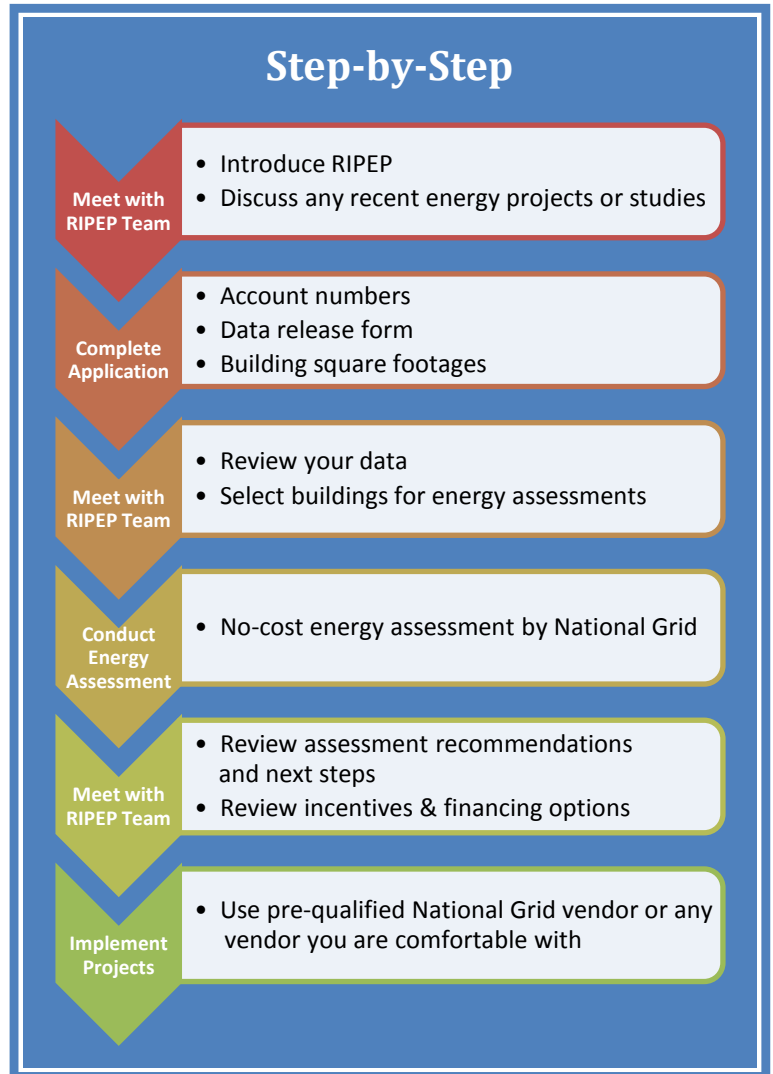
Deep energy savings for the public sector

Benefits for Municipalities

The Rhode Island Public Energy Partnership (RIPEP) can help you lower your operating costs by reducing energy consumption in your municipal facilities. Benefits include:

- National Grid **incentives** for qualifying energy efficiency projects. Additional incentives may be available through the RI Office of Energy Resources.
- Projects may qualify for **on-bill repayment**, which provides interest-free financing for your portion of the project cost.
- Projects may be **exempted from competitive bidding** requirements when the installation is completed by National Grid-approved vendors.
- The cost of technical or other required **studies may be subsidized**.
- **Support** for project coordination and completing efficiency applications may be available.

RIPEP is a precedent-setting collaboration, led by the Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (OER), to achieve deep energy savings in state and municipal facilities.
